NJ Transit rail service is available from the Mahwah station, Passengers may also take advantage of express service on the same line from the Ramsey Route 17 station located on Route 17 South.

Parks & Recreation

Ahwah Library is state of the art, offering many events and classes for children, teens and adults.

Mahwah's town <u>pool</u> is home to The Mahwah Marlins Swim Team and Dive Team, and offers group swim lessons for young children.

<u>Campgaw Mountain Reservation</u> is a Bergen County accredited park, covering 1,351 acres in
 Mahwah and portions of Oakland, that has campgrounds and ski slopes for skiing.

Darlington County Park is comprised of 178 acres and is nestled at the foothills of the Ramapo Mountains in Mahwah. The park features three lakes, white sand beaches, a wooded picnic area, open lawns, tennis and handball courts, and a bird and wildlife observation. DCP is open to the public.

Ramapo Valley County Reservation is a 4,000-acre county park known for its miles of hiking trails for hikers of all skill levels.
